Motor Cycle Frames for Heavier Models

The "James" Motor Cycle Frames are well-designed structures, built for the accommodation of the engine, gear box, and other units of the

complete motor bicycle, making with them a mechanically efficient and well - balanced machine. The design embodies

all the necessary technical essentials relative to steering lead, rake, etc., and also provides for the heavy stresses imposed upon the various

members of the frame. Only the highest class weldless steel tubes are used in their construction, and these are, wherever necessary, specially drawn tubes, tapering from the thickened butt to normal gauge, thus allowing the vibration to be dissipated over the entire area of the tube. The fittings of the frames are so designed as to combine great strength with good appearance. Permanent lugs for mounting the tank and other fittings are provided, thus eliminating risks due to slackening clips and bolts. The general design provides a very low saddle position which brings the centre of gravity very low, ensuring freedom from skidding and safety at all times.

Frames and Forks for Lightweight Models

The Frames and Forks embodied in the "James" Two-Stroke Models are exceedingly strong and well designed, built and brazed as a complete unit and not dependable on

bolts and nuts to hold it together in any way. The Engine and Gear Box are housed snugly within the loop, and are readily mounted and at the same time easily accessible for any purpose.



THE FRAME.-This is built of the highest grade weldless steel tube, and the main frame tube is specially drawn with a taper extending its whole length from the Head Lug diminishing to normal gauge at the Seat Lug. The Spring Fork is of distinctive and effective design, having a single spring similar to the larger "James" models. Shock Absorbers are built integral with the fork on the De-Luxe Model, and may be had at a slight extra on the Standard Models. Tecalemit Lubricators are used for all Fork Shafts and other

bearings, ensuring thorough lubrication. The Fork Stem Tube is heavily taper-butted to ensure safety, and the steering angle provided insures easy steering at all speeds on any condition of road.

JAMES Spring Forks

The "James" Spring Fork is a distinctive feature of "James" machines; the particular design helps to account for the

wonderful steering qualities of the "James" machine. Large diameter shock ab-sorbers, which are easily adjustable for friction, are now fitted. These permit the use of a very flexible fork spring, and check objectionable rebound.

Combined with the large tyres now standardised, they ensure extreme comfort and safety under all conditions. Other details which add to the efficiency and long life of the forks are the provision of Tecalemit grease gun nipples to each fork shaft, ensuring thorough lubrication. The old "James" practice of using heavy butted steering columns for the fork crowns are still adhered to, and the fork blades are taper butted, and fitted with long liners. All fittings are brazed

on, no loose clips being used throughout.



Enlarged View of Front Brake

The design of efficient brakes for motor cycles is a point which has exercised the minds of designers probably more than any other feature outside the power unit. The brakes fitted to all "James" models are well protected from mud, water, and grease, and may be relied upon under all conditions to function effectively. The illustration shows the all-enclosed speedometer drive which is a feature of our 1930 models. No effort has been spared to ensure

that the material used in their construction is the best procurable for the purpose.



Lubrication of Two-Stroke Models

A special automatic system of lubrication is employed on all "James" Villiers Two-Stroke Models.

In this system the variations in the crankcase pressure are utilised to supply oil according to requirements, and crankcase suction distributes this oil to each point required.



*Compressed air from the crankcase passes along the centre of the shafts to the holes " J " which register with grooves in the crankcase bushes when the piston is descending. The air passes through holes drilled in the crankcase to a union situated in front of the crankcase. From this point it is conveyed through the pressure pipe "A" to the top of the oil tank, raising the pressure in this and forcing oil up the pipe "B" in the same way as soda water is forced up the centre tube of a soda syphon. The oil passes the regulating screw "F" and issues from a small hole into the cup of the sight feed. From this the oil descends to the engine through a union "D" on the front of the cylinder. Here the oil divides, part of it being sucked through a hole in the cylinder wall uncovered by the piston, and the rest passing down to the crankcase, where it is again divided between the two main bearings. Grooves in these register with ports "K' in the crankshafts when the piston is ascending, and the surplus oil is sucked through the drilled oilways "E" to the big end. The adjusting screw "F" is set when the engine is sent out to supply rather more oil than is normally required. After running 300 miles, this should be screwed in slightly to reduce the oil supply. The correct setting has been obtained when a faint blue haze of smoke issues from the exhaust pipe. The sight feed is provided to ascertain if oil is flowing, and not to gauge the quantity. In the ordinary course of events, this lubricator is entirely

In the ordinary course of events, this lubricator is entirely automatic—starting and stopping with the engine—and delivering oil as demanded by the load of the engine.

The oil tank must be kept absolutely airtight. Castrol XL Oil should be used.




After Sales Service

Three-Speed Gear-Box (Patent No. 6606/12).

Is fitted to models B.1 to B.6. It consists of an aluminium casting machined to receive the annular bearings in which the gear shafts run. The gear shafts are made of unbreakable axle steel, case hardened and ground to fine limits. The gears are made from a direct hardening steel, possessing under stress a tensile strength of 150 tons per square inch.



The "James" gear-box is of very generous proportions low and high gears have constant mesh pinions, their engagement being effected by a sliding dog mounted on the countershaft. Both gear shafts are mounted in annular ball bearings, the one at the clutch end of the main shaft being a particularly large bearing, which is provided to stand unlimited wear without the necessity for adjustment. The sectional illustration given shows the general arrangement.
