





The Duplex Girder Frame

This illustration shows the construction of the bracket on the Royal Enfield Duplex Girder Frame. This Frame is our own registered design, and embodies immense strength and stability. Under test, one of these frames has withstood a strain of 4,536lb.—over two tons—and the enormous reserve strength it possesses may be gauged, when it is remembered that the riding strain exerted by the average cyclist rarely exceeds 500lb. The absolute rigidity of this type of frame ensures a complete utilisation of power, and we very strongly recommend it on account of its many advantages. It is fitted to our Models Nos. 113, 115, 120, 151 and 161.




The Royal Enfield Coaster Hub




The ROYAL ENFIELD HOOD and WIND SCREEN

THE model illustrated on this page is one of our standard side-car models fitted with a special type of collapsible Hood and an adjustable Wind Screen. These are not supplied as part of the standard equipment of our model, but we fit them, when desired, at a reasonable extra charge.

The accompanying illustration shows the Hood folded back, out of use. It is made from specially woven waterproof material, and all the straps and fittings are of the very best quality. It can be brought into position in a few seconds and is secured by a stout leather strap passing through a bar fixed on the front of the side-car body. The Screen is both neat and effective, and is easily adjustable to any angle required—either being brought close up to the occupant of the side-car or turned down flat when not required. Two wing nuts control the adjustment.

The Screen swings round to permit of the side-car door being opened easily.

for which a separate guarantee is issued (see our Motor Cycle List).

A LL "ROYAL ENFIELD" Bicycles made and equipped in accordance with the specifications in this Catalogue are guaranteed as follows, and the guarantee applies to every detail of a complete bicycle, including tyres, rims, saddles, gear cases, etc.

We give the following guarantee with our machines instead of the guarantee implied by statute or otherwise, as to the quality or fitness for the purpose of cycling of goods supplied by us; any such implied guarantee being in all cases excluded. In the case of machines which have been used for "hiring out" purposes, or in respect of which our Trade Mark or manufacturing number has been removed, no guarantee of any kind is given, or is to be implied.

We guarantee, subject to the conditions mentioned below, that all precautions which are usual and reasonable have been taken by us to secure excellence of materials and workmanship; but this guarantee is to extend and be in force for one year only from the date of purchase, and the damages for which we make ourselves responsible under this guarantee, are limited to the cost of repairs to the cycle. We undertake, subject to the conditions mentioned below, to make good at any time within a year any defects in these respects to our cycles. The guarantee does not apply to defects caused by wear and tear, misuse or neglect.

Any cycle sent to us to be plated, enamelled, or repaired, whether the repairs are required for the purpose of making good the defects before referred to or otherwise will be repaired upon the following conditions—i.e., we guarantee that all precautions which are usual and reasonable have been taken by us to secure excellence of material and workmanship, such guarantee to extend and be in force for one year only from the time such work shall be executed, and this guarantee is in lieu and in exclusion of any common law or statute warranty, and the damages recoverable are limited to the cost of any further work which may be necessary to amend and make good the work found to be defective.


CONDITIONS OF GUARANTEE

If a defective part should be found in any of our machines at the date of purchase or after the repairs above referred to have been executed by us it must be sent to us, carriage paid, and accompanied by an intimation from the sender that he desires to have it repaired free of charge under our guarantee, and he must also furnish us at the same time with the number of the machine, the name of the agent from whom he purchased, and the date of purchase, or the date when the alleged defective repairs were executed as the case may be.

Failing compliance with the above, no notice will be taken of anything which may arrive but such articles will lie here at the risk of the senders; and this guarantee, or any implied guarantee, shall not be enforceable.

We guarantee only those machines which are bought either direct from us or from one of our duly authorised agents, and under no other conditions.

Our guarantee does not apply to road-racing or light roadster tyres on machines, nor to the tyres of machines sent out of the United Kingdom





CONDITIONS OF SALE

A LL goods are sold subject only to the conditions of guarantee given on the preceding page, and a copy of this guarantee will be found in the tool-bag attached to each bicycle. The guarantee applying to Royal Enfield motor cycles will be found in our motor cycle catalogue.

All Machines, except motor bicycles, specified in this catalogue are packed in crates free of charge, and consigned by Goods Train carriage paid, to any station in the United Kingdom.

Notwithstanding payment of carriage, all goods are to be considered as delivered to the customer when put on rail at Redditch Station, and all orders are accepted and executed upon this understanding.

Upon receipt of goods by the customer, it is essential that the railway company's delivery sheet should in all cases be signed "not examined." The goods should then be carefully inspected, and in the event of any damage should at once be sent to the carriers, and claim made from them.

Cases and crates for shipment abroad are charged at cost price.

The specifications in this book are subject to modification at any time without notice.

REPAIRS AND SUNDRIES

These cannot be booked—our terms being Net Cash on receipt of pro-forma invoice.

Machines or parts for repair must be sent carriage paid, and the name of the sender attached, or they cannot be received. Full instructions, with advice as to the mode of despatch, should be posted same day. Before forwarding bicycles it is advisable to remove all easily detachable fittings, not intended for repair, such as lamp, bell, luggage carrier, saddle, etc.

When ordering sundries, customers are respectfully requested to quote the identification number for each part required, which numbers will be found in our Sundries Booklet. It is also desirable that the number of the machine should be stated. Please mark all communications—"Cycle Repairs and Sundries."
