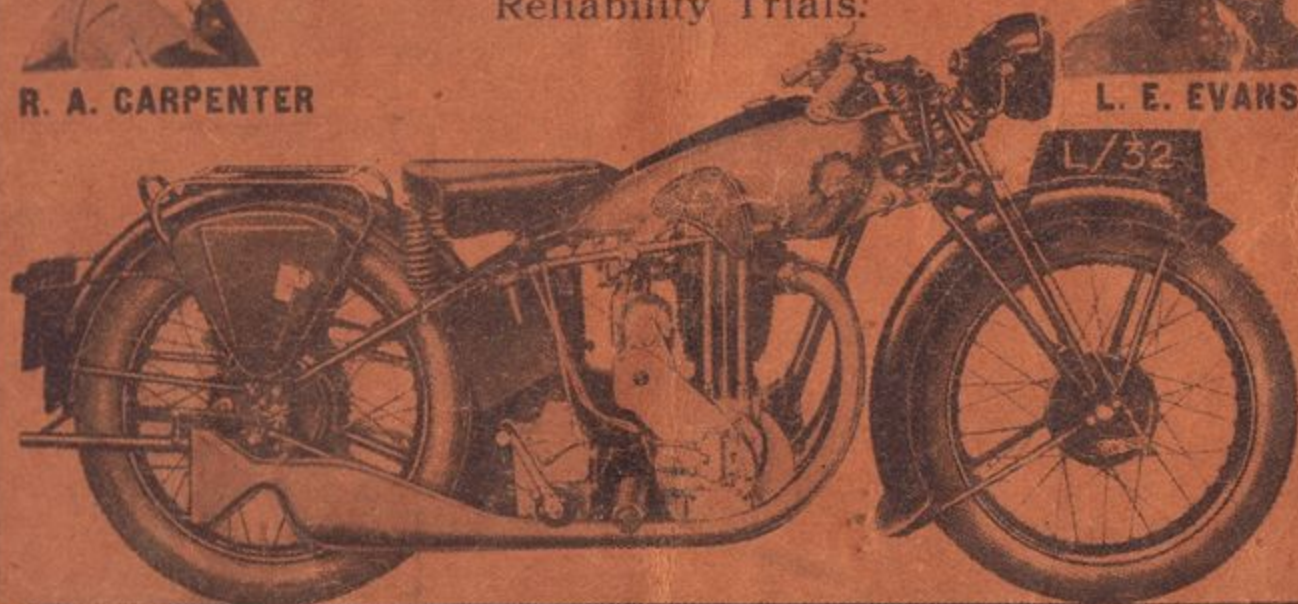

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**CONDITIONS.**

1. The Committee reserve the right:
  - (a) To add, delete, substitute, or amend Events on the Programme at any time.
  - (b) To re-handicap any competitor.
2. All races are run under the Rules and Regulations laid down by the N.Z.A.C.U. and all competitors must comply with such.
3. **Competitors ride at their own risk.** The Club or its officials will not be responsible or liable for any accident or injury that may occur.
4. **Only bona fide Competitors allowed in Saddling Paddock.**
5. The Stipendiary Stewards shall have power to debar any Competitor or machine from starting in a Race, who, in their opinion, is unfit to do so.
6. Any competitor intending not to start in a Race must notify the Secretary at least ten (10) minutes before the Race.
7. Any Competitor will be allowed to ride one lap only before the start of his Race at the discretion of the Starter, who, when ready to group the riders for starting will show a red flag. Any Competitor disregarding this signal renders himself liable to disqualification.
8. Under no circumstances will a Rider be allowed to ride on the course in the opposite direction to that in which the Races are run.
9. When finishing a Race, Competitors must not turn Machine round to enter enclosure, but must circle the course for one lap only and come down the straight at an easy pace.
10. Any Competitor disregarding any of the above rules renders himself liable to instant disqualification.
11. Protests will be considered by the Protest Committee, and same must be in writing and handed to the Secretary or Judges within 15 minutes of the finish of the Race or Heat, accompanied by a deposit of 10s., which will be forfeited if the protest be considered frivolous.
12. Acceptances must be made within seven minutes after finish of preceding Race.
13. All laps must commence from the inside rail.

CONDITIONS—continued.

14. That in the event of a protest of the C.C. of a machine being incorrectly stated, the prize money will be held over until such machine is examined and certified. The rider of machine will be allowed to ride in any further race if he chooses.

A rider who has nominated more than one machine must notify the Number Steward as to which he intends riding within ten minutes after conclusion of prior race.

Competitors are notified that Exhaust Pipes must be bent away from the ground.

The Public are prohibited from Trespassing on the Track. Any one breaking this regulation will do so at their own risk.

A White Flag will be shown to each Rider starting on his last lap; the Chequered Flag will be shown to the placed Riders. Upon seeing the Chequered Flag all competitors must complete another lap and pull up alongside the inner rail and remain there until directed by the Flag Steward to enter the Bird Cage. A Red Flag will be shown at Finish of Race and also in case of an accident, or when it is desirable to stop a race or Riders, on seeing which all Riders must stop immediately.

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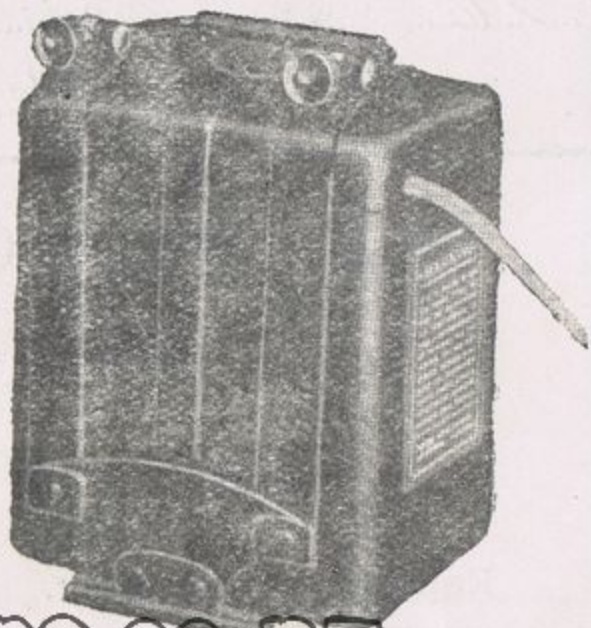

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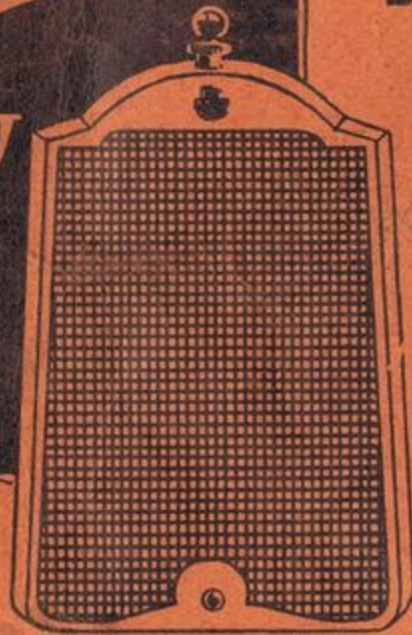
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
